The International Yacht Restoration School held their Two-Part Paint: Rolling & Tipping class on March 15 at the Hinckley Company.

Two-Part Paint: Rolling & Tipping is part of IYRS's Continuing Education Program and was presented by Michael Casey from Providence Lacquer.



Diversified Finishes – Navy Ship

Diversified Finishes did a restoration of the Admiral's Barge. The Admiral's Barge is a 50' wooden boat. Diversified Finishes stripped the boat down to bare wood then sprayed 4 coats of HMG Polykote MPS 4 + 1 Primer Filler. They let that dry and sanded it back and sprayed 2 more coats of HMG Polykote MPS 4 + 1 Primer Filler which they tinted black. They sanded that back and sprayed 3 coats of HMG Acrythane XSC Black topcoat.

Ballentine's Boat Shop

Ballentine's Boat Shop fixed up and painted a 36' Islander Sailboat.

Some modifications were made to the deck. Which was primed with HMG Polykote AMC Primer Surfacer. It was sanded back and sprayed with HMG Acrythane XSC Matterhorn White topcoat.

The hull was also primed with HMG Polykote AMC Primer Surfacer and sprayed with HMG Acrythane XSC Greystone topcoat.



Campbell's Boat Works

Campbell's Boat Works did a complete restoration on a 1950 18' Century.

They sealed up the new teak with the MAS Epoxies Low-Viscosity Resin mixed with Medium Non-Blushing hardener.

Then, they sprayed 2 coats of HMG K-Type Clear Gloss over the entire boat. The boat was then sanded back with 400 grit. Then they sprayed 2 more coats of HMG K-Type Clear Gloss.
